2. What are the **ages** of those you anticipate traveling?
3. **How many** participants do you expect? (Most cost effective is approximately 40.)
4. How many **staff** do you plan to bring? What role do you expect them to play? Do their costs need to be built into the participant costs?
5. **When and for how long** do you want to come?
6. What level/type of **accommodations** do you require?
7. Please tell us about your **goals** for the trip. Be sure to **include issues, themes, people or organizations** you are interested in meeting.
8. What type of **Shabbat** experience do you want?
9. Is your community involved in the Partnership 2000 initiative, Sister-City, congregation twinning or other **ongoing relationship with Israel**? If so, please give details.
10. Please tell us **anything else** that is important we know in order to help you create the right program and itinerary for you.
